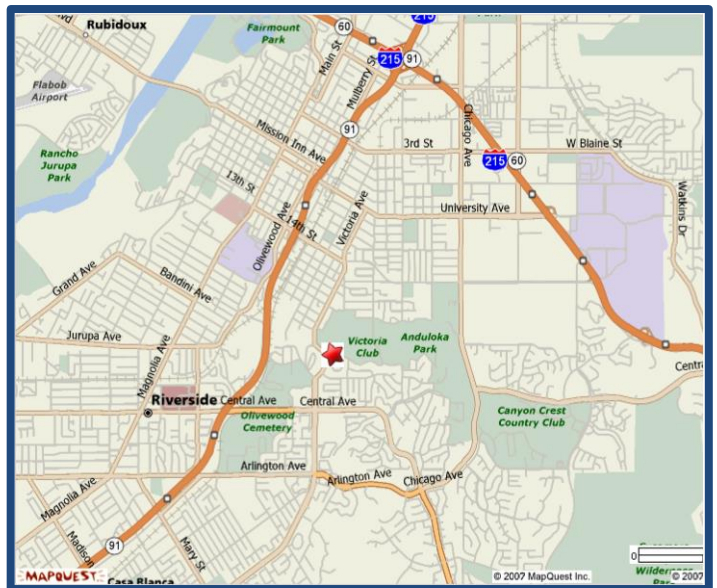

Course Description

The Victoria Club is one of the oldest golf courses in Southern California. Designed by Charles Maud, it first opened to play in 1903, and still has much of its original charm, measuring 6,486 yards from the back tees.

There is a lake on the first hole and a large creek bed meanders throughout the course. Accurate shot placement is crucial because of flanking trees located on many of the holes.

An historical training ground for some of Southern California's most successful golfers. PGA Professionals Gary McCord & Don Pooley hail from the Victoria Club.
