Growing Compassion - \$20,000

Your gift can fund:

- Enhanced Medical Services (EMS) Program, which helps improve or maintain the health status of:
- · Children with special healthcare needs who are dependent on the court system due to abuse or neglect.
- Women who have experienced domestic violence or sexual assault and require specialized medical care and support.
- The implementation of future programming benefiting work with children who experienced abuse or neglect and human trafficking victims.
- Arctic Sun Medical Device used to help with children who have experienced trauma



Nourishing Strength - \$10,000

Your gift can fund:

- Specialized training for staff who investigate child abuse and neglect.
- Forensic video interviews secure cloud-based storage system that protects both children and women who have experienced domestic violence or sexual assault from re-experiencing trauma by ensuring they only have to share their story once.
- Portable forensic interview system.
- The ongoing upgrading, service and maintenance for critical program equipment, such as the forensic exam photography system and interview recording equipment.



Seeding Resilience - \$5,000

Your gift can fund:

- Enrichment opportunities, programs and services for children who have experienced neglect or abuse.
- Specialized training for Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) including Forensic Pediatrician, law enforcement, District Attorney, Therapist, and other staff members.
- Subscription membership to CalSAFE
- Upgrades and warranties on special equipment used during interviews and forensic exams.
- An annual supply of art therapy supplies, books, toys, games, and other experiential child-friendly items to improve the child's experience during therapy and ongoing behavioral health sessions.
- Annual SAFE/RCCAT Multi-Disciplinary Conference



Cultivating Courage - \$2,500

Your gift can fund:

- Training on Child and Family Traumatic Stress Intervention (CFTSI), an evidence-based treatment modality. CFTSI is designed to reduce traumatic stress symptoms and the risk of onset Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder when implemented in the peri-traumatic period (e.g. 30-45 days after a potentially traumatic event or after recent disclosure of physical or sexual abuse).
- Subscription to National Children's Alliance database system for tracking and reporting cases.



Household of Hope - \$500

Your gift can fund:

- Car seats, luggage, clothes, diapers and nourishment for kids visiting and receiving care. Belongings bag filled with personal hygiene and comfort essentials.
- Assistance with Safe & Reliable Transportation ensuring access to medical exams.
- Membership in Child Advocacy Centers (CAC) of California chapter of National Children's Alliance, who provides Training, Technical Assistance, and Support for CACs in California. Materials for family resource packets handed to each caregiver.
